Folk music tells the stories of people and places, and Canada's James Keelaghan has certainly honed that skill. Twenty-five years after his first album, he has established himself as a singer/songwriter with a strong following in North America, Europe, and Australia, having a compelling ability to tell the stories of himself and his land using his phenomenal baritone voice. He is widely considered to be one of Canada's finest singer/songwriters. James has performed on the main stage of some of the most prestigious festivals in the world including Denmark's Tonder Festival, the Australia National Festival, the Hong Kong Festival, the Sidmouth International Folk Festival (England), the Kerrville Folk Festival (US), and all of the major Canadian folk festivals. He's now got 11 albums to his name, one of which won a Juno award (Canadian Grammy) for Best Roots Traditional Recording and three others of which were nominated for Junos. He is a masterful storyteller, with his songs conveying marvelously etched historical stories. It's been 8 years since James has been here, and it's truly amazing to get him back for a house concert!
