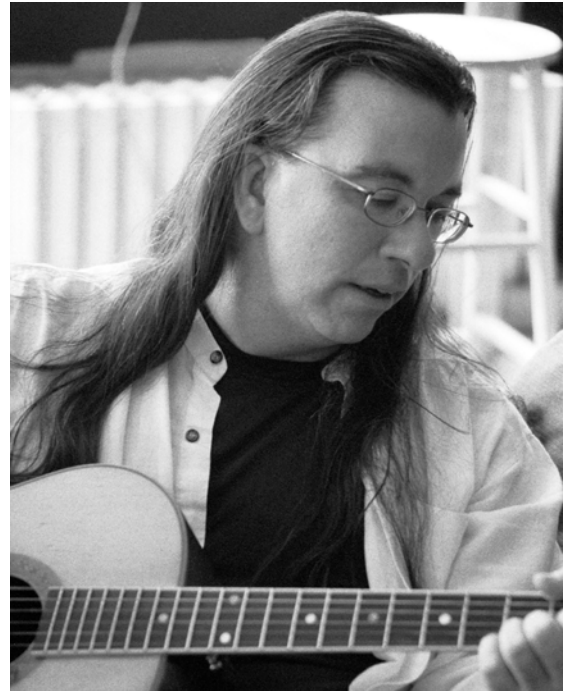


**JAMES KEELAGHAN,

James has performed on the main stage of some of the most prestigious festivals in the world including Denmark's Tonder Festival, the Australia National Festival, the Hong Kong Festival, the Sidmouth International Folk Festival (England), the Kerrville Folk Festival (US), and all of the major Canadian folk festivals. He's now got 7 albums to his name, one of which won a Juno award (Canadian Grammy) for Best Roots Traditional Recording and two others of which were nominated for Junos. He's earned international acclaim for his songwriting and performances. It's truly amazing to get him to Berkeley for a house concert!
